



DISCUSSION QUESTIONS FOR DOG SONGS BY MARY OLIVER

1. What were your initial impressions of "Dog Songs"? How did the poems resonate with you personally?
2. How did the collection meet or differ from your expectations of Mary Oliver's work, especially in the context of writing about dogs?
3. How does Mary Oliver capture the relationship between humans and dogs in her poems? What emotions and aspects of this bond does she highlight?

11. How do the themes of "Dog Songs" extend beyond the relationship between humans and dogs? What universal insights about life and love can be drawn from the collection?
12. How does "Dog Songs" fit into Mary Oliver's broader body of work? In what ways does it continue or diverge from her other poetry?
13. Which poems from the collection were your favorites, and why? What made them stand out to you?
14. What do you think is the overall message or theme of "Dog Songs"? Did the collection effectively convey this message?
