The collection includes a broad range of fiction and nonfiction, such as:

**Classics/literary    Poetry    Spanish language    Historical & local interest**  
**Biographies    Identity/EDI topics    Sci-fi, fantasy, romance, thrillers, and more!**

- **Sets have 8+ copies and come with discussion questions and other materials.**
- **Sets are transported via the CLIC courier service, or pick-up is arranged at CSL.**
- **Staff members at enrolled institutions keep track of the set and return it to C912.**
