The Colorado Center for the Book Speakers Bureau brings engaging Colorado authors to libraries, schools, and other cultural nonprofits throughout Colorado. We help organizations identify the kind of literary event that is right for their community, book one of our Speakers Bureau authors, and promote the event. Organizations then schedule the event directly with the author, pay travel expenses, may contribute to the honorarium (paid by Colorado Humanities), and work with us to promote the event. Colorado Humanities contracts with the speakers and pays honoraria that hosts may contribute to if they wish.

Our 2022-23 speakers include 2020, 2021, and 2022 Colorado Book Awards finalists and winners. They can read from their work, lecture, lead workshops, or join book club discussions about their work. Visit coloradohumanities.org/programs/ccftb-speakers-bureau for the full list of available speakers.
